FINAL Key Meeting Outcomes

Administrative Business and Announcements

California Sea Grant Fellow Claire Nasr oriented attendees and advisory council members with introductions regarding sign-in and audio/video set-up, with help from staff member Lizzie Duncan and Senior Policy Analyst Katie Denman. Nasr then went over the protocol for how to participate appropriately. Sanctuary deputy superintendent Mike Murray conducted a roll call resulting in the presence of 36 council members representing 20 voting seats (see Appendix 1). In addition, 25 non-member public attendees participated in the Webinar. In total, 74 individuals registered for the virtual meeting, and 61 individuals attended the webinar.

Member appointments

Council Chair Phyllis Grifman announced 11 recent member appointments to the advisory council. This included: Giles Pettifor, Paul Amaral, Dr. Kim Selkoe, Tim Athens, Samantha Macks Franz, Ben Pitterle, Dr. Tony Knight, Dr. Stuart Kasdin, Douglas Williams, Phyllis Grifman, and Dr. Robert (Bob) Miller. Murray also recognized and thanked outgoing council member Richard Block for his many years of service on the council.

Council Member Brief Announcements

Council members shared a variety of announcements about recent events from their respective agencies and groups.

July 18th, 2020 Draft Key Outcomes

By unanimous voice vote led by Chair Phyllis Grifman, the council approved the draft key outcomes from the July 18th, 2020 advisory council meeting. A copy of this document is available upon request to claire.nasr@noaa.gov.

Sanctuary Superintendent's Report

Sanctuary superintendent Chris Mobley began by addressing the impacts of COVID-19, explaining how it is continuing to affect activities at the sanctuary including mandatory telework and a lack of field work and dive operations. Mobley acknowledged NOAA

Office of Law Enforcement representatives from the West Coast Region in attendance, Andrew Torres and Kimberly Bell, who introduced themselves. Mobley also provided a brief announcement that students from CSU Channel Islands enrolled in a Land Use Management course led by former council member Russell Galipeau, as well as graduate students from a UC Santa Barbara Bren School course in Ocean and Coastal Policy, may be contacting council members to better understand policy issues and gain insight on management. Mobley acknowledged the one-year anniversary of the dive vessel Conception tragedy, and shared information on the newly placed 'memorial stone' at Platt's Harbor, Santa Cruz Island. Mobley's presentation also included highlights from a successful marine debris clean up at Yellowbanks on Santa Cruz Island, and staff efforts on sound monitoring and other acoustic deployments occurring within the sanctuary. Following Mobley's remarks, a brief staff update was provided by Chris Caldow and Dr. Jennifer Selgrath about new work starting up focused on better understanding human use within the sanctuary. In addition, a brief announcement was made by guest Morgan Visalli regarding the UCSB Benioff Ocean Initiative's new "Whale Safe" web portal. Claire Nasr closed out this portion of the meeting by sharing highlights from a recent member questionnaire pertaining to online advisory council meeting productivity and participation.

Vandenberg Air Force Base Spacelift Mission

Walter Schobel, the Chief of Airspace and Offshore Management Section at Vandenberg Air Force Base, and a Sanctuary Advisory Council Member, provided an overview of the Spacelift Mission at Vandenberg Air Force Base. The briefing was designed to provide the council with an overview of Vandenberg AirForce Base operations. Schobel presented information pertaining to Western Range operations, host base services, missions and launches. His presentation concluded with future Spacelift projects, and taking questions from the audience. For a copy of the presentation slides, contact claire.nasr@noaa.gov.

Public Comment Period

Russell Galipeau described a project for the Land Use Management course he is teaching at CSU Channel Islands, inviting council members to participate in upcoming interviews that will be requested by students.

CINMS Management Plan Update Process

Mike Murray presented information about the current status of the management plan revision process, showing and explaining a process roadmap. Special care was given in providing slightly more background information due to the high number of 'first time' attending members. Murray provided an overview of priority topics for which staff will develop issue-based action plans: Climate Change, Vessel Traffic, Introduced Species, Marine Debris and Marine Zoning. Murray also explained that the next management plan will also contain programmatic action plans for key sanctuary functions: Education & Outreach, Research & Monitoring, Resource Protection, Maritime Heritage, and Operations & Administration. Murray concluded by reminding the council that there will likely be special topic webinars in the near future focused on select high

priority issues and outlined the next steps in the revision process. Finally, council members were invited to provide feedback and ask questions, including after the meeting. Presentation slides are available upon request to michael.murray@noaa.gov.
