	4	The MX is presently unable to determine if the shift is due to the Emissions Control Area change from 24 to 200 miles on 1 January 2015, congestion, or something else.								
	5	The 2015 12 month Total row accounts for all ships that arrived one month and departed the next month; the monthly counts do not.
