


# RESPONSE HIGHLIGHTS FROM MAY 19 - JUNE 22



## First 24 Hours

- 911 call reports oily smell
- County personnel notify OSPR and USCG
- Santa Barbara County Fire Department locates source of oil
- Plains local personnel respond w/ Fire Department and Office of Emergency Management respond to incident
- Multiple reports to NRC
- Clean Seas activated
- Plains' emergency response plan activated
- Patriot Environmental activated
- 4 response trailers mobilized
- Skimmer vessels arrive and begin collecting oil
- NRC notifies EPA
- Vacuum trucks begin recovering oil from release site
- USCG consults with U.S. Fish and Wildlife, NOAA, National Marine Fisheries Services
- Oiled Wildlife Care Network and pre-trained volunteers activated
- 3,000 feet of boom deployed at El Capitan and Refugio Beach
- ICP established at County EOC
